

Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm)

ELIGIBILITY

Passed in 10+2 examination (science academic stream) with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology or Mathematics. or any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination.

Admission to D.Pharm:

- **Through JEECUP counselling:** Candidate has to appear and qualify the Joint Entrance Examination Council (Polytechnic), Uttar Pradesh JEECUP. Then, candidate has to participate in JEECUP counselling and choose College Code-1978. Aspirants can use the given link: <https://jeecup.admissions.nic.in/>

Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm)

ELIGIBILITY

For B. Pharm 1 st Year:

Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and or Biology (P.C.B / P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

B. Pharm lateral entry (to third semester)

Candidate shall have passed D. Pharm. course from institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.
